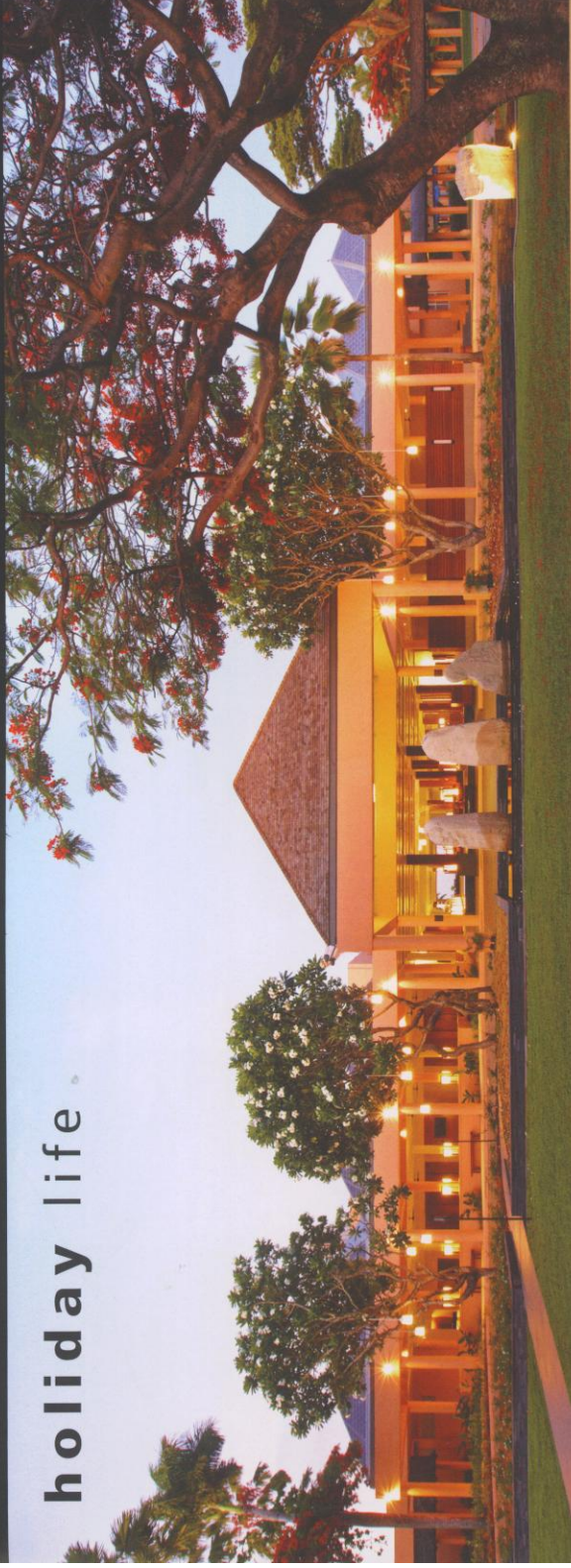

The multi-award winning Sheraton Fiji Resort on Denarau Island in Fiji has always been in popular demand for those heading away for some rest and relaxation. In 2008 it was named the Travel + Leisure – Top 25 Hotels in Australia, NZ and South Pacific, an accolade that joins the growing list of awards the resort has received. With this kind of reputation to uphold, the Sheraton Property Management team takes immense pride and care to ensure the resort buildings and interiors reflect the image that guests expect.

The second five star resort to open on Denarau Island, it was first built back in the mid-1980s and opened its doors to guests on November 20, 1987. A collaboration with two neighbouring resorts means guests can enjoy the Sheraton Fiji Resort facilities as well as those of the adjacent Sheraton Denarau Villas and The Westin Denarau Island Resort & Spa. The resort provides so much choice with 17 restaurants and six swimming pools that you can try a different one each day, in between trying out the championship golf course, polishing your tennis prowess, getting an award winning spa treatment or relaxing and soaking up the sun.

As part of their planned maintenance programme, the resort has recently undergone a full refurbishment. In keeping with the style of the resort, the exterior has been finished in Resene Sureseal followed by Resene X-200 waterproofing membrane in a custom made 'Sheraton Peach'. Guests are kept safe on pathways that traverse the property with a Resene Non-Skid Deck and Path finish. Weathered decks are freshened with decking stain to rejuvenate their look and provide protection against the elements.

The colours of the sandy beaches are brought indoors with hotel walls finished in Resene SpaceCote Low Sheen (high wear areas) and Resene Zylone Sheen (tinted to Resene Canterbury Clay (muted beige) with gloss waterborne enamel tinted to Resene Canterbury Clay. Hallways are finished in Resene Lumbersider tinted to Resene Space Shuttle (brown grey) for a soft greyed look that is easy on the eyes, providing a good transitional zone for guests to acclimatise to indoor lighting from the striking sunlight outside.

To enhance and protect timber surfaces, they are finished in Resene TimberLock with Resene Uracryl 403 Clear topcoats, while timber furniture also enjoys a Resene TimberLock finish but with Resene Uracryl 405 topcoats.

In true Sheraton style, the property management team are kept busy keeping the resort in tip top shape, while guests relax in style blissfully unaware of the hive of activity... just the way it should be.

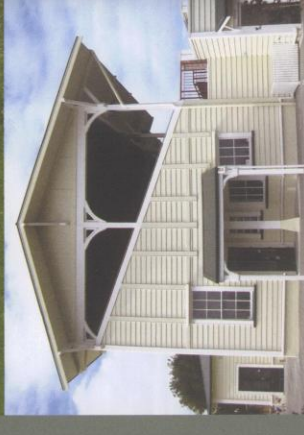

grand mover

The much loved Grandstand of Cambridge has had four different homes over its life. Originally built at the Cambridge Raceway in 1878, it was subsequently moved to the Claudelands in 1887 before being moved again in 1926. When the Claudelands track was closed the decision was taken to preserve the history of the Grandstand by moving it across the park to its present site and to refurbish it as a function centre.

The Grandstand is now exquisitely restored to protect its history and bring it up to modern standards. The exterior timber weatherboards are finished in Environmental Choice approved Resene Sonyx 101 semi-gloss waterborne enamel tinted to

Designed and made locally, Coast has developed the Cayo and Off-the-hook range of outdoor furniture. The ranges are made from sustainably local grown pine and finished with Environmental Choice approved Resene topcoats. Resene Wood Primer is used to lock the preservation treatment into the timber, before undercoating with Resene Environmental Choice approved Resene Quick Dry and topcoating in Resene Lustacryl semi-gloss waterborne enamel tinted to Resene Quarter Sisal (pale hemp). The cushions feature Sunbrella fabric and quick-drying, marine grade reticulated foam, which allows them to stay outside, rain or shine.

The Cayo range is civilised living... outside, while the Off-the-hook range cleverly combines everything you need to live outdoors – cushion, mat, deckchair and towel – with a free-standing or wall mounted board to keep it together when you're not using it.

Once the building work was complete, the full house was painted in a consistent colour scheme, a job completed with such care and attention that the old and the new appear as one. The exterior Cedar weatherboards, were finished in Environmental Choice approved Resene Lumbersider tinted to Resene Black complemented by Environmental Choice approved Resene Hi-Glo white on wooden window surrounds, fascias and eaves.

The icing on the cake of this residential project came in the form of the Master Painters Best Exterior Repaint award, an added bonus for the owners who were already delighted with the seamless finish of their extended home.
